Apostolic History In The Making!

It has always been our desire and eventual calling from God to enlarge & support, train & encourage leaders in general and indigenous leaders in particular.

Multi National Leadership!

The latest fruit of this process was in May this year when the time had come for our Argentinean missionary friends – Danny & Damaris Pedraza – to pass the baton to the teams they had trained. EMMANUEL church is in Liepaja, W Latvia and as many are, the congregation comprises Russian and Latvian believers. The Pedrazas have been there for 9 years and have faithfully built this church so that it now engages in missions trips, trains its own leaders and more recently,

has some of its members in the Bible School.

The practice of not only ethnic diversity, but multi lingual communication is well established and it was essential to install Russian and Latvian pastoral teams. They have been instructed and trained up in the ministry and the gospel has now been committed & entrusted to them. It was a glorious Sunday morning when we had the privilege of commissioning four couples by the laying on of hands.

A New Kind Of Bible School

Danny is the principal of the newly launched national Bible and Missions School, but will continue to cover the new leadership in Liepaja. Our role is to continue to cover the Pedrazas and input the church about twice a year. The first academic year commenced with 30 students of whom 28 graduated. What a joyous 'ceremony' it turned out to be! None of the usual formality of caps and gowns for them! Just the exuberant delight of having the opportunity to study the Word and offer themselves in God's service. As the former USSR, it is an immense opportunity afforded to them and now this is available, it seems there is no shortage of eager students.. It is an intense learning curve for some and one couple came with their small son, Joseph and left their elder daughter in the care of relatives back home. They are now the resident caretakers and deans of the School and after refurbishing a small flat there, the whole family is together serving the Lord in this great way. Others are in full time service at the home church. This year, we have 37 and they are just as keen! Colin has just returned from a good week of teaching and Sunday ministry.

The car for the Pedraza family has now been purchased and they are appreciative of such a good vehicle for the weather of the Baltics! There has been a need for a media projector for the Bible School and we have recently been informed that the funds have been raised by a church in England and will be taken in December when two of the church's leaders will teach in the school.



Still talking of schools...this is a different kind, for children this time. All the funding has been raised for the first phase of the LUMINARY SCHOOL in Lusaka, ZAMBIA. Building has commenced this autumn with the well being bored, a school compound wall being build and the first school classroom buildings erected. This is for about 300 children whom Colin visited last year and so many have responded to this appeal for a good building with educational facilities and resources for the many impoverished and orphaned children.
